Background question

How can we organize locally as university staff and students?

Context: genocide in Palestine and Swansea University

(what I am aware of)

There is a genocide going on

torture, bombing, ethnic cleansing, kidnapping, murder, siege, famine, expulsions, theft, apartheid

- settler-colonialism, started in the 20th century
- since October 7th 2023, in Gaza alone:
 - > 68000 confirmed direct kills (Gaza Health Ministry)

Gaza universities all bombed

The UK is currently complicit

Arguably #2 ally of Israel, with an historic responsibility

Aspects of complicity in the UK today:

- political
 - diplomacy
 - · repression of activism
- media coverage
- military
 - intel sharing
 - · exporting of arms to Israel

How can a UK university be complicit?

- Investments: at least £456M invested by UK universities (PSC)
- Collaboration with the "defence" industry
 - advertisement
 - research grants, contracts
- Collaboration with Israeli universities and industry
 - Joint degrees, specific grants . . .

Also a UK university could be supportive of Palestinian liberation

- BDS, scholarships, ...
- UCU support at the national level

- Divestment from Barclays after student encampment (06/2024)
